

2023 TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

PURPOSE:	Reporting to Mayor and Council on transportation safety and neighbourhood traffic calming, as well as to liaise with other agencies as necessary in carrying out these duties.
OBJECTIVES:	<p>The focus of the Transportation Advisory Committee will be on four areas:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <u>Neighbourhood Traffic Calming</u>: A comprehensive citywide study will be conducted in phases to define and prioritize traffic calming neighbourhoods. The Committee will provide input in scheduling neighbourhoods for public consultation and reviewing the recommendations from the study. 2. <u>Vision Zero Focus Areas</u>: Delta is in the process of adopting a Vision Zero Strategy and have developed the following focus areas based on collision data analysis <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Intersections • Vulnerable Road Users • Pedestrians – Older Adults and Youth • Vehicle Speeds • Heavy Vehicles <p style="margin-left: 40px;">The Committee will review the Vision Zero work and report back to Council.</p> 3. <u>Active Transportation Programs</u>: Improved active transportation connections are key to enhancing our community's health, environment, economy and ensures residents can safely move in and around Delta. The Committee will provide review of the work Delta is engaged in under the Cycling Master Plan and also pedestrian safety enhancements across the community. 4. <u>Emerging Transportation and Safety Issues</u>: The Committee will respond to emerging transportation and safety issues referred by Council.
MEMBERS	<p>The Committee will be comprised of the following members</p> <p>2 Council members (1 member would be appointed chair) City Manager General Manager, Engineering and 1 other staff member Delta Police Deputy Chief and 1 other police member</p> <p>Other agencies such ICBC, Delta School District, TransLink can be invited as required</p>
