Information About Application

What is the Local Government Election?

The City of Delta is holding elections on October 20, 2018 for the Office of one Mayor, six Councillors and seven School Trustees.

Who can request a Mail Ballot Voting Package?

Eligible voters can apply to vote by mail if any of the following conditions apply:

1. You expect to be absent from the City of Delta at the times of all Advance Voting Opportunity (October 6, 10 and 11) and on General Voting Day (October 20), or
2. You have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects your ability to vote at another voting opportunity for this election.

Eligible voters applying to vote by mail must be:

1. 18 years of age or older on October 20, 2018; **AND**
2. a Canadian citizen; **AND**
3. a resident of the City of Delta for at least the past 30 days **OR** a non-resident owner of real property in the City of Delta for at least the past 30 days; **AND**
4. a resident of BC for at least the past 6 months; **AND**
5. not disqualified by law from voting in an election.

What delivery methods are available for my Mail Ballot Voting Package?

The following options are available for delivery of your Mail Ballot Voting Package:

1. Keep the package at the Office of the City Clerk for you to pick up
2. Mail the package to your residential address
3. Mail the package to an address you specify

When will I receive my Mail Ballot Voting Package?

If your application is filled out correctly, the Chief Election Officer will send you a mail ballot package by **October 9, 2018**. If your application is received after October 9th and time does not permit mailing, you should arrange to pick up a package from the Office of the City Clerk.

How do I request my Mail Ballot Voting Package?

Before 4:00 pm on Thursday, October 18, 2018, submit your completed application form by mail, email, fax, or in person to:
