So Community Grants program was developed to formalize city's efforts to support community organizations with the initiatives aimed to improve well-being and belonging in Delta.

40

The program was informed through multi-month research we conducted with other municipalities about their community grants programs.

41

And a formal policy was developed in 2024 and approved by Council in May of 2024.

Following this, we had first two rounds of the program this year and last year.

43

And this year marks the second year of the program.

So what is the purpose of the program?

47

00:04:07,760 --> 00:04:21,160

As mentioned, the Community Grants Program allows eligible organizations, namely not-for-profit organizations and registered charities, to apply for funding to support projects, programs, and initiatives that benefit the Delta community.

48

So to provide you with some examples, in the past, we funded programs for at-risk use, supported local community events, and provided funding to buy materials, for example, for quilting programs, projects for the Delta Hospital.

49

So we'll go over the criteria for the program a little later today.

50

But essentially, this program is developed to support initiatives that aim to achieve five goals.

51

We would like to strengthen and enhance the well-being in Delta.

52

We'd like to provide funding for programs that benefit residents facing multiple disadvantages.

53

We'd like to fund programs that promote funding, cultural understanding, and inclusivity.

54

Also, we'd like to see more collaborations in our community and support programs that foster partnerships with other service providers in Delta.

And finally, we'd like to fund programs and services that are inclusive and available to all Delta residents.

So the Community Grants program has a budget of 150,000 per year.

58

And as you may know, we have two intakes.

59

We opened this intake in mid-November, and the deadline to apply for the first intake of this year is January 15th, and we're hoping to notify all the applicants of their application status in the spring of this year.

60

We'll then open our second intake in April 2026, and with applicants being notified of their application status in the fall of 2026.

61

Applicants will have a full year to spend their allocated funding once awarded.

So we recommend considering very carefully which intake you would like to apply for based on your needs and the timing of your initiative.

So I thought it might be good to share with you about our first year.

With the program, as with other funding programs, our program received many, many more applications that we could possibly award.

65

To give you an idea, last year we received 59 applications.

And across this 59 applications, the total funding requested was over \$419,000.

67

So we were able to award grants to 33 organizations, but of course, with our budget of \$150,000, we could not give every organization the total funding that they requested.

As such, we just wanted to kindly remind you that we may not be able to award you the total amount that you're asking for.

So, for example, if you request a maximum amount eligible of \$10,000, we may only be able to award you a portion of that.

All this information can be found on the City's webpage, Community Grants Program, but we just really wanted to make sure that we provide you with this information and you have an opportunity to ask questions.

So to be eligible for a community grant, organizations must meet three criteria.

75

00:07:27,600 --> 00:07:41,040

Be a not-for-profit organization with a BC society number or charitable registration number, provide services that primarily benefit Delta residents, and not receive any other supports from the City of Delta.

76

So the supports may include permissive tax exemptions, service agreements, or any other funding supports.

77

That being said, there are some exemptions to this.

78

For example, if your organization receives a facility rental grant for your initiative, you'll still be eligible for a community grant as those two funding sources often go hand in hand.

79

In any case, if you're unsure of any funding that you receive from the City and how it may impact your eligibility for community grant, please don't hesitate to reach out.

We have an open door policy, we'll always reach out back.

So in the past, we also had some questions about eligible expenses.

Just to give you an example, this will include some supplies and materials, event infrastructure.

This is the City of Delta Community Grants Program website.

So how you would get there is you would go to delta.ca, scroll over to Community and Culture, go down to Social Planning, and then right here, a little up from the bottom, you'll see Community Grants Program.

And so all of the information that we are covering in the session today, you can find here.

The arguably most important part is the application form.

104

So I'm going to open that up right here, and you can grab that just by clicking on Apply Now.

Okay, and Olga, are we seeing the application form on the screen?

We are, brilliant.

All right, I'm going to zoom in a little bit here.

108

So this application form is a fillable PDF.

109

So you should be able to just fill it in in your browser, and then you can download it and e-mail it to us at communitygrants@delta.ca, and we will then share it with the evaluation panel.

So let's just take a moment to see.

If I were filling out this grant application, I'm going to start filling it out right at the top here.

112

00:10:35,120 --> 00:10:38,320

So I can just type in my organization.

113

I can type in our address here.

114

00:10:42,800 --> 00:10:48,480

And these fields up here have a character limit of 100 characters.

115

So for this one especially, if it isn't big enough, say for your e-mail address or for your address, you're always welcome to take that and put that in the body of the e-mail when you send your form in.

116

That's not always the case for every section here, which we'll chat about in a little bit, but we definitely want to make sure we get all of your information there.

117

So you can see it's pretty straightforward how to fill that part up at the top here.

118

So that's all of your contact information.

When you scroll down here, you'll see the spot for either your BC Society number or your charitable registration number, which again is a requirement in order to be eligible for a City of Delta Community Grant.

And so then we get here into the larger section.

Describe what your organization does and identify the key benefits to residents of Delta.

122

These larger sections here have a character limit of 300 characters.

123

What that looks like in practice.

124

Here I'm going to show you.

125

is that once you hit the 300 character limit, it's actually going to cut you off.

126

So we're going to just paste this in a whole bunch right here.

127

00:11:55,360 --> 00:11:56,960

That's where my 300 stops.

128

00:11:57,200 --> 00:12:07,600

So as you are filling out the form and you're filling in these larger text spots, just make sure you're keeping an eye on where it gets cut off because we won't see anything beyond that 300.

129

So right here, I'm going to put in the amount of funding that I'm asking for.

130

00:12:12,840 --> 00:12:18,720

Our maximum here, I'm going to put in \$10,000, and that's going to show up somewhere else as well.

131

I say, let's say I didn't receive any funding from the City of Delta last year, so we're going to put in zeros there.



132

Okay, so as Olga mentioned, organizations are only eligible for a community grant if you're not receiving other sources of funding from the city, of course, with some exceptions like the facility rental grant.

133

So right here, you'll be able to indicate whether you have received other sources of funding or not.

134

00:12:42,720 --> 00:12:48,240

In this case, we're going to assume that I haven't, so we'll click no, no, no, no.

135

00:12:48,480 --> 00:12:50,400

And you won't be able to click both options.

136

00:12:50,400 --> 00:12:52,320

You can only click one or the other.

137

00:12:53,760 --> 00:12:57,600

All right, so continuing on here, this is where we get into the fun stuff.

138

So now you get to start telling us what the program is that you're applying for and all the great things about your organization for why the City of Delta's Community Grants Program should offer you funding.

139

So we're going to say we're doing a new program.

140

00:13:11,560 --> 00:13:14,400

We're going to say it is for capital.

141

00:13:14,640 --> 00:13:21,040

So for some infrastructure upgrades for, you know, for our nonprofit office here where

142

We're putting in a new desk.



143

How about that?

144

00:13:23,760 --> 00:13:26,000

And our organization is based in Delta.

145

00:13:26,240 --> 00:13:33,800

Let's say we served 150 people last year, and let's say all 150 of them were Delta residents.

146

00:13:33,800 --> 00:13:40,880

So that means that the proportion of individuals that our organization served were 100% Delta residents.

147

00:13:41,600 --> 00:13:50,240

As I mentioned, right here in these larger text boxes, you have a character limit of 300, so just keep an eye on those to make sure you're not getting cut off.

148

And let's say we anticipate our initiative's going to serve 300 Delta residents this year.

149

00:13:56,720 --> 00:13:59,360

So our organization supports lots of Delta residents.

150

00:13:59,600 --> 00:14:02,400

The new equipment is going to help us to maximize that.

151

00:14:02,480 --> 00:14:04,720

We're going to serve double what we served last year.

152

I'm not going to fill out these sections here, but you can see they are larger text boxes.

153

00:14:10,000 --> 00:14:14,080

So you can chat about outcomes of the program if you received funding last year.

154

In our example case, we didn't, so we're going to skip that.

155

00:14:17,600 --> 00:14:22,160

And if we don't receive the funding that we're requesting, what is the impact to the program?

156

00:14:22,160 --> 00:14:33,200

So as you're filling this out, really consider how the funding that you are requesting is going to help to further your organization's goals and further the goals of the City of Delta Community Grants Program.

157

And if you're not successful, how that will be impacted.

158

All right, so scrolling down here, so this is a new section that we added in.

159

00:14:41,680 --> 00:14:51,840

So here we have divided up the criteria for the program that the program helps to meet, and we give you the opportunity to let us know how you are going to meet these criteria.

160

You'll see right here that there is a link to a rubric.

161

00:14:57,520 --> 00:14:59,040

Oh, it actually took me there too.

162

00:14:59,840 --> 00:15:03,440

So you can see exactly how we'll be evaluating the applications.

163

We will go over that a little more in a bit.

164

I'm just going to go back to our little form here.

165

OK, I'm scrolling down, scrolling down.

166

So if you want to see that criteria rubric, the hyperlink is here right within the form.

167

00:15:17,040 --> 00:15:20,480

But each of these sections, again, will have a character limit of 300.

168

00:15:20,640 --> 00:15:24,480

So you can let us know how you're going to meet each of these criteria.

169

Let's just say this will allow our organization to reach lots of people.

170

That's not necessarily meeting this criterion, but you get the idea.

171

And then you can pick a score of 1 to 5.

172

00:15:40,480 --> 00:15:42,880

So we're going to give ourselves a 5 for that.

173

00:15:42,880 --> 00:15:49,280

And this will allow you to score on each single criterion that our evaluation panel actually also looks at.

174

So to give you some insight into the evaluation process, and I'll touch on this again in a little bit, our panel receives these applications and then they score each of these criterion on a scale of 1 to 5.

175

So you'll get the opportunity to score yourself and then we'll be able to see how your scores line up with the evaluation panel scores.

So you'll be able to fill in all of these on the scale of 1 to 5, fill in the text for up to 300 characters, and as your response gets longer, you will see a little arrow show up here that allows you to scroll through so you'll be able to see your full response.

Okay, then we get into the proposed budget breakdown.

178

00:16:28,640 --> 00:16:29,920

So my

application here reset.

180

So let's just put in that we're requesting \$10,000 just for a second here.

181

00:16:38,960 --> 00:16:40,960

So once we get to the budget breakdown.

182

00:16:41,520 --> 00:16:45,760

you will see that it automatically fills in with the total that you're applying for.

183

00:16:46,080 --> 00:16:55,280

So it'll ask you to break down each of the expenses and the anticipated amount that each expense will be for this particular program or initiative.

184

So let's say for supplies and materials, we anticipate spending \$2,000.

185

Let's say we don't have any event infrastructure costs, so I'm going to make that a zero.

186

Let's say we're spending \$5,000 on fees.

187

00:17:11,440 --> 00:17:15,760

And we'll do \$2,000 for marketing materials here.



188

You can see that the total proposed spending does not yet add up to the total we're applying for.

189

00:17:20,800 --> 00:17:23,440

So you'll just want to make sure that those are aligned.

190

00:17:23,839 --> 00:17:31,360

And then for other costs here, we'll ask you to put in both the total that you're applying for and also what those costs are for.

191

00:17:31,360 --> 00:17:34,960

So in this case, let's say I want to buy \$1,000 worth of balloons.

192

00:17:35,120 --> 00:17:43,040

So you can fill that in there and you'll see the total amount for your budget adds up to the total amount that you are applying for.

193

And then finally, once we get down to the bottom here, you'll see the conditions of our funding.

194

00:17:48,640 --> 00:17:55,680

So stating that unused grant funds provided by the City for the purposes described in the application form must be returned.

195

If you don't spend all the money that you're given for the thing that you are applying for, we ask that you give that back.

196

00:18:01,680 --> 00:18:07,920

If the application form contains any misrepresentations, the full amount of the grant may be repayable to the city.

197

We will be requesting a short report on the outcomes of the initiative.

198

We'll talk about that a little bit later on in the session, but there will be a template provided to you to support you with that report.

199

And then we also reserve the right to request receipts following the completion of the initiative.

200

So we ask that any receipts that you have for the initiative that you've received funding for, you just hang on to those because we may ask for them at a later time.

And then finally, here at the bottom, you have the opportunities to sign.

So you can either put in an e-signature or you can just type it in here.

It's up to you, whatever works best for the program that you are using.

And then once you have completed that form, you will save it to your computer or your device and e-mail it over to us at communitygrants@delta.ca.

So support of well-being for the Delta community.

how it benefits residents experiencing disadvantages or discrimination, promoting volunteering and cultural understanding, working with community partners, and also inclusiveness of programs and services.

And as you saw with the application form, the scoring rubric is available on the city's website.

217

So here towards the top of the rubric, you'll see the scores from one to five here along the left side are each of the criteria that the evaluation or that the applications will be scored on by both the evaluation panel, but also you when you are submitting your own, your own self scoring.

So if we're looking at a criteria that's a 1, typically that is something that does not meet the criteria at all.

So as an example, for strengthens and enhances the well-being of the Delta community, a 1 does not do this at all.

It doesn't strengthen, it does not contribute to the well-being of Delta.

Something like a 5 would significantly strengthen community well-being and actively focus on the diverse experiences and needs of Delta residents.

And again, I'm not going to walk you through the scores from one to five.

This is all available online, so you'll be able to see all of it for sure on your own.

But staffing costs are more operational.

And so this program would not cover those.

Do you accept applications from organizations that do not have audited financial statements?

270
