



This tree was planted for the service and enjoyment of the residents of Delta. With some care by homeowners and a regular maintenance program by City staff, trees can provide valuable social and environmental benefits for generations.

## PLEASE DO:

Water the tree with at least 15 gallons of water per week during the hot summer months.

Keep the base of the tree mulched and free of grass and weeds as they will compete with the young tree.

## PLEASE DO NOT:

Prune or fertilize the tree. City arborists are available to attend to the tree as required.

Operate lawn mowers or line trimmers at the base of the trunk. This can damage the bark and will harm the tree.

Mound up soil or mulch against the trunk. A depth of no more than 8 centimeters or 3 inches of composted mulch is all the tree needs to keep roots cool and moist.
