- 4. To sign an elector response form you MUST meet the qualifications as either a Resident Elector or a Non-Resident (Property) Elector of the City of Delta. If you are unsure if you qualify, please contact the Office of the City Clerk at 604-946-3220.

- 6. One elector of the City of Delta may sign each Elector Response Form.
