- ✓ Entries must endeavour to maintain a safe distance from other parade units without creating gaps
- ✓ No fires, smoking or vaping on or near the floats
- ✓ Good brakes, proper driver's vision, and ventilation are required
- ✓ Candies and other articles are NOT TO BE THROWN FROM FLOATS

Canada Day Parade Regulations



1. All entries must be approved by the City of Delta.
2. Parade entries must observe all rules and regulations issued by the City of Delta and follow all instructions from Police and Parade Officials.
3. The City of Delta reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade either prior to assembly, at assembly, or at any time during the parade.
4. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle or on the person of any parade participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade are subject to removal from the parade. No fires, smoking or vaping on or near the floats.
5. Floats or other entries advocating, opposing, or depicting any political, religious or social issues that in the opinion of the City of Delta do not meet the objectives of the parade will not be allowed to participate.
6. No materials may be handed out, thrown, or in any way distributed from a moving vehicle. Material may only be handed out by accompanying pedestrians.
7. Only forward maneuvers by vehicles and marching units are permitted.
8. Entries that do not appear for the parade without prior notice to parade officials, or entries that do not comply with the rules and regulations, jeopardize future invitations to the Canada Day Parade.
9. The Parade Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries in each category.
10. The Parade Committee's decision regarding all entries is final.
11. Floats must be delivered to the parade assembly area no later than 1:30 pm on the day of the parade.
12. All entries must register their arrival at the Parade Check-in Table located at North Delta Secondary School before 1:30pm.
13. In the event of a float breakdown, all parade entries are to proceed around any such problem. Do not worry about getting out of sequence. Keep the parade moving.
14. The City of Delta Parade Committee will be stationed along the route and have the authority to regulate spacing. Your cooperation with these officials will be appreciated.
15. At the end of the parade route (Burnsview Secondary) please disperse safely and quickly so that the area does not become a point of congestion. Vehicles may proceed down 112th Street and turn onto either 74a Ave or 72nd Ave to leave the area.
16. All vehicles must be road worthy with good brakes and proper ventilation. All objects must be secured to the float. Parade float size requirements are based on the BC Ministry of Transportation Guidelines (maximum height 13.5ft or 4.15m, maximum width 8.5ft or 2.6m). All vehicles require \$2mm liability auto insurance to the satisfaction of the Parade Committee.
17. Driver's vision must not be obstructed.
18. All drivers must possess a valid driver's license.
19. Any participants displaying any form of racism, discrimination, hate speech or any other acts of aggression or violence while participating in the parade will be removed.
