### The Reason

- The eleventh annual **Luminary Festival** will be held in Sunstone Park on Saturday, September 7, 2024. This event is very popular, and once again, we request your cooperation to help keep this festival at Sunstone Park safe and successful.
- To ensure a safe evening for all in attendance, the parking and traffic flow in your neighbourhood will be impacted.

### Your Assistance is Requested

The section of the road selected for closure will ensure the majority of Sunstone residents continue to enjoy unobstructed vehicular access and egress. There is a small section of residences across from the park whose access and egress will be assisted by traffic control personnel. (see map on reverse side)

If you live in this impacted area, please:

- Familiarize yourself with the traffic disruption and parking restrictions as mentioned above, in order to avoid unnecessary delays or frustrations.
- Do not park your vehicle in the restricted area, as staff, and volunteers will be on the roadway setting up festival booths, hosting activities, and directing shuttle buses transporting people.
- **VEHICLES LEFT BEHIND IN THE RESTRICTED AREA WILL BE TOWED TO BROOKE ROAD.**
- If you must drive on Delsom Crescent during the closure, we ask that you allow extra travel time and take directions from certified traffic control personnel on site.
