CITY OF DELTA BYLAW NO. 8386, 2024



A Bylaw to establish fees and charges for services and information

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Delta deems it expedient to provide for fees and charges for services and information;

AND WHEREAS section 194 of the *Community Charter* authorizes municipalities by bylaw to impose fees in respect of a service of the municipality or provision of information;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it necessary and desirable to exercise the authority provided by the *Community Charter* to recover costs of providing services and information;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Delta in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

#### **PART 1: CITATION**

1.1 This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "**Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024**."

### **PART 2: FEES AND CHARGES**

- 2.1 The City of Delta hereby imposes the fees for the provision of services and information as specified in Schedules 1 to 13 inclusive, which are attached hereto and form part of this bylaw.
- 2.2 Fees or charges imposed under this Bylaw for the provision of services or information shall apply in place of any fees or charges imposed under other bylaws for the same services or information in the event of any conflict between this Bylaw and any other bylaw. A reference to a more specific matter in this Bylaw supersedes a reference to a more general matter.

### Severability

2.5 If any part, section, sub-section, clause or sub-clause of this Bylaw is, for any reason, held to be invalid by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, it must be severed and the validity of the remaining provisions of this Bylaw must not be affected.

### **Paramountcy**

2.6 To the extent of any inconsistency between the provisions of this Bylaw and the provisions of the Act or the Charter, the provisions of the Act and the Charter prevail.

#### **PART 3: REPEAL**

- 3.1 Delta Miscellaneous Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 5888, 2001 as amended is hereby repealed.
- 3.2 Delta Credit Card Payment Service Fee Bylaw No. 7749, 2018 is hereby repealed.
- 3.3 Consolidated Fees Bylaw No. 7273, 2013, as amended, is hereby repealed.
- 3.4 Delta Parks, Recreation and Culture Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8044, 2021, as amended is hereby repealed.

#### **PART 4: EFFECTIVE DATES**

- 4.1 Schedules to this Bylaw shall come into effect on January 1, 2025, except for Schedule 11 Parks, Recreation and Culture shall into effect April 1, 2025.
- 4.2 Repeals listed as 3.1, 3.2 and 3.3 shall come into effect on January 1, 2025.
- 4.3 Repeal 3.4 shall come into effect on April 1, 2025.

#### PART 5: BYLAWS AMENDED

- 5. The following Bylaws are hereby amended:
  - (1) Delta Animal Control and Licence Bylaw No. 6893, 2010 is amended by deleting Schedules A, B and C; and adding the following: "Schedule 2 Fees and Charges: Fees and Charges for services that may be or are provided under this bylaw shall be payable as set out in the Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024."; and further by removing and replacing all references to Schedules A, B and C in the bylaw and replacing with "Schedule 2 Animal Control of the Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024."
  - (2) **Delta Building/Plumbing Bylaw No. 6060, 2002** is amended by replacing every reference "Bylaw No. 7273" with "Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024".
  - (3) **Business Licence Bylaw No. 7670, 2017** is amended by deleting Table 1 of Schedule A, and by removing and replacing all references to Table 1 of Schedule A with "Schedule 4 Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024"; delete 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule "A" and add to Part 4 Definitions as follows: "Engaged" means using or used in connection with the Business within the Municipality in any manner

- (6) **Delta Harbour Regulation Bylaw No. 6990, 2012** is amended by deleting Schedule B and replacing all references to "Schedule B" with "Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024."
- (7) Delta Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Bylaw No. 8408, 2024 is amended by deleting Schedule 1 and replacing all references to "Schedule 1" with Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024."
- (8) **Delta Soil Deposit and Removal Bylaw No. 7221, 2014** is amended by deleting part 12 of the Bylaw and replacing it with "12. Subject to section 14 of this bylaw, every permit application shall pay fees as identified in Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024."; and in section 31 by deleting "and Section 12" and replacing with "and Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024"; and in section 32 by deleting "of \$200" and replace with "as identified in Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024"; and in section 50 by deleting "in the sum of \$1.00 for each and every cubic metre of soil removed or deposited" and replace with "as identified in Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 8386, 2024".

The Delta Parks, Recreation and Culture Fees and Charges Bylaw (Bylaw), defines the fees and charges applied to recreational, cultural, park facilities, and associated City of Delta amenities.

### DROP-IN ADMISSIONS, PASSES, AND REGISTERED PROGRAMS

### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- (1) Drop-in Admissions provide access to Recreation Centres (Skate/Swim/Gym/Fitness), Outdoor Pools, Art & Performance Centres, and Community Centre Drop-In Activities.
- (2) Patrons under the age of seven (7) must have a guardian with them at all times while participating in a drop-in activity within a Delta facility.
- (3) Delta Families First Initiative Two-week advance booking for registered programs for Delta residents.
- (4) Leisure Access Assistance Program Recipients pay \$5.00 per eligible family member, per six months; persons with disabilities pay \$10.00 per year; applicable taxes included.
- (5) Patron Admission Categories
  - i. Infant (Under 2 years)
  - ii. Child/Youth (2 18 years)
  - iii. Adult (19 59 years)
  - iv. Senior (60 74 years)
  - v. Super Senior (75+ years)
- (6) Free Admission to Drop-In Activities applies to:
  - i. Child/Youth (18 and under) Delta Residents only
  - ii. Volunteers accompanying persons with special needs
  - Infants (excluding Roaming Rascals, Sport Zone, and Parent & Tot for Non-Delta Residents)
  - iv. Super Seniors (75+ years) Delta Residents only
- (7) Single Admission (Drop-In)
  - i. Pass is non-transferable
  - ii. Photo ID required
  - iii. Valid at any City of Delta recreation facility
  - iv. In the event of an unforeseen facility closure, or medical consideration (doctor's note may be required), a complimentary pass may be issued
- (8) 30 Day Pass
  - i. Pass is non-transferable, valid for 30 days from date of purchase
  - ii. Prorated refunds for relocation outside of Delta may be considered when proof is provided

# (9) Flex Pass (10 or 20 Visits)

- i. Valid for one-year from date of purchase
- ii. Prorated refunds for relocation outside of Delta may be considered when proof is provided
- iii. In the event of an unforeseen facility closure, or medical consideration (doctors note may be required), prorated refunds or complimentary passes may be issued
- iv. No refunds or extensions for planned annual facility maintenance closures or age category changes
- v. Photo ID required
- vi. Valid at any City of Delta recreation facility

### (10) Annual Pass

- i. Valid for 365 days from date of purchase
- ii. Pass is non-transferable
- iii. Prorated refunds for relocation outside of Delta may be considered when proof is provided
- iv. In the event of an unforeseen facility closure, or medical consideration (doctors note may be required), prorated refunds or complimentary passes may be issued
- v. No refunds or extensions for planned annual facility maintenance closures or age category changes
- vi. Photo ID required
- vii. Valid at any City of Delta recreation facility

### 2. CANCELLATION POLICY - REGISTERED PROGRAMS

### (1) Recurring Registered Programs

Applies to weekly/biweekly swim lessons, skate lessons, dance/music/art programs, sports programs, general programs, etc.

 Prorated refund available for any withdrawals prior to the start date of the 3<sup>rd</sup> class. Once the 3<sup>rd</sup> class starts, no refund will be provided.

#### (2) Camps, Workshops and Short Programs

Applies to Registered Programs that are one weeklong or less including Weeklong Camps (Summer Camps, Winter/Spring Break Camps, Kids on Wheels, etc), One Day Programs/Workshops, Birthday Parties, and Pro-D Day Camps.

 Withdrawal required one week before the start date to receive a full refund. If less than one week's notice is given, 50% of the fee will be refunded. If notice is given after the start of the program, no refund will be provided. Bylaw No. 8386 Page 32 of 50

### (3) Preschool and Before/After School Care

Applies to Preschool and Before/After School Care

One calendar month written notice must be given by the last day of the month preceding the final month the child will be enrolled in the program (e.g. withdrawal notice must be received by January 31 if the child will no longer attend as of March 1).

## (4) Advanced Aquatics

Applies to Bronze Star, Bronze Medallion, Bronze Cross, Lifesaving Instructor, National Lifeguard, Water Safety Instructor/Swim for Life Instructor, all Aquatic Re-certifications, Pool Operator 1, Pool Operator 2, and Standard First Aid.

 Withdrawal required one week before the start date to receive a full refund. If less than one week's notice is given, no refund will be provided.

# (5) Private Lessons and Personal Training

Applies to Swimming, Skating, and Personal Training

- 24-hour cancellation notice required for refund. If less than 24 hours' notice is given, no refund will be provided
- (6) Medical and relocation exceptions will be considered if documentation is provided.
