Looking to build a detached **accessory dwelling unit (ADU)** on your property? This catalogue provides example designs from the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC) and the Province, that meet Delta's zoning regulations, subject to BC Building Code compliance.

Please be advised that building an ADU is dependent on the constraints of your individual lot (e.g. required setbacks and lot coverage). If you are interested in the designs in this catalogue, please contact a designer to tailor the design to your individual property. 





## **GARDEN SUITE B**


1-Storey Garden Suite 70 sq. m (750 sq. ft)

## **COACH HOUSE**


**2-Storey Coach House** 159 sq. m (1,716 sq. ft)
