CALL FOR COMMUNITY PIANOS IN DELTA SUBMISSIONS

City of Delta is excited to continue *Community Pianos in Delta*. The program features painted pianos in public spaces that the community can play and also enjoy music played by trained pianists. *Community Pianos in Delta* are installed at Elliott Street Wharf and Diefenbaker Park seasonally.

Community Pianos in Delta inspires new and different uses for public spaces and promote music by making it accessible to the community.

City of Delta is seeking submissions from community members to paint one of two upright community pianos. Local artists are invited to submit a proposal.

SUBMISSIONS

- Open to residents of Delta of all ages
- All artworks must be original and made by the applicant
- We only accept email submissions to culturalservices@delta.ca
- Two artists will be chosen to each paint one upright piano
- The deadline for submissions is the end of day **Sunday, May 31, 2026**
- All submissions will be reviewed by City of Delta Staff
- Successful artists will be contacted by Wednesday, June 3, 2026

ARTIST RESPONSIBILITIES

- Sign ownership of your work over to City of Delta if successful
- Agree to have your photo taken and be part of City of Delta's promotion of *Community Pianos in Delta* and Pop-Up Parks
- Be available to paint at Douglas J. Husband Discovery Centre beginning June 4 and be completed by June 13

DOUGLAS J. HUSBAND DISCOVERY CENTRE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Keep all submissions confidential
- Provide the piano, supplies, and an appropriate space for work to be done
- Issue a \$250 honourarium to each artist upon completion

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All information provided under the submission is subject to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (BC) and shall only be withheld from release if an exemption from release is permitted by the Act. The artist shall retain copyright of the submitted documents. While every precaution will be taken to prevent the loss or damage of submissions, the City and its agents shall not be liable for any loss or damage, however caused.
