# School Programs

## CEDAR, WOOL & FEATHERS GRADES K – 2

Textile arts help us convey our complex identities. Learn about how natural resources contribute to Delta's diverse cultural fabric. Practise your weaving skills and design a quilt square in this engaging and tactile program.

## DISCOVERING DELTA GRADES 3 – 4



How does the geography and ecology of Delta affect development, transportation, and communication? Learn how Delta is formed through a live water table demonstration. Explore the historic and modern challenges of Delta's geography.

## IMMIGRATION STORIES GRADES 5 – 7

How do immigrants shape the cultural landscape of Delta? Discover stories of Delta's immigrant populations, the hardships they face, and how they have become key members of Delta's communities.

## TRAIL EXPLORATION AND SELF-GUIDED TOUR ALL GRADES

Learn about Delta's diverse histories through a physical and digital experience. Follow the TRAIL system for an interactive tour through our themed kiosks and explore the rest of the exhibitions with a structured self-guided tour.

## DIGGING ROOTS GRADES 7

Students explore ancient civilizations and Delta's past through an immersive TRAIL and board game experience.

## WINTER WONDER GRADES PRESCHOOL – 2; 3 – 6

Between November 10 - December 17, explore how Delta's communities celebrated the holiday season and braved the cold by completing a winter-themed scavenger hunt and making a winter craft to take home.
