Water Meter Service – Leak Adjustment Request Form



Property owners can apply for a one time leak adjustment credit for excess water volume charges resulting from a leak which the owner or occupier could not reasonably prevent. Property owners that have previously received a credit are not eligible to receive further leak adjustment credit.

To be eligible for a leak adjustment you must have repaired the leak within three weeks from the discovery of the leak, and provide proof of the leak repair (i.e. receipts and invoices for any materials or services related to the repair).

If you wish to apply for a leak adjustment, please complete the form below and return it to the Engineering Department at City Hall or email it to engineering@delta.ca along with the proof of repair. If your leak adjustment request is approved, either a credit will be applied to your next utility bill, or if it is approved early in the billing season, you may receive an amended bill in the mail. Credits less than \$100 will not be processed. Utility bills must be paid before the due date to avoid late penalties.
