DELTA SENIORS BUS

The Delta Seniors Bus service is a free, convenient transportation option available to seniors 65 and older who live in Delta. This service is designed to help seniors remain active and independent by offering access to key local destinations such as medical facilities, shopping centres, recreation areas, and other essential services. Seniors can book a ride up to seven days in advance, and the bus will make curbside stops at their homes for pick-up and drop-off.

To ensure smooth and efficient service, passengers are asked to be ready at their curb ten minutes before the scheduled pick-up time. This bus service is fully equipped to accommodate mobility devices like wheelchairs and small scooters, allowing seniors with different needs to use the service. While passengers must be able to independently board and disembark, caregivers and companions are expected to assist if necessary.

Availability of rides depends on demand, but the program continues to offer a vital resource for seniors looking to maintain their independence and stay connected to their community.

The Delta Seniors Bus provides easy access to medical services, recreation centres, shopping, and other community amenities.

Equipped with an automatic lift, the bus can accommodate wheelchairs, walkers, and scooters, ensuring everyone can travel comfortably.

City of Delta residents aged 65 and older can book free rides to appointments, shopping trips, or visits with friends.

Simply call 604-597-4876 between 9 am and 4 pm to register or book a ride up to 7 days in advance.

Medical appointments receive priority booking, but all rides are subject to availability. Book your ride today!

Licensed service animals are welcome.

An assessment of wheelchairs or mobility scooters is required, including:

- ▶ Measurement of the device, demonstration of the passenger's abilities, and securing the device for safe travel.
- ▶ Passengers with mobility scooters must take the stairs when boarding the bus; the lift will be used for the scooter only.
- ▶ Assessments are done every two years, and with new devices.
- ▶ Passengers requiring enhanced accessibility services due to mobility or memory challenges are encouraged to explore alternative transportation options including arrangement of a caregiver for 1-1 assistance.

The Delta Seniors Bus is designed for City of Delta residents who can independently board, disembark, and navigate their surroundings.

Passengers must be able to:

- ▶ Register independently for the service and schedule rides
- ▶ Embark and disembark the bus without assistance
- ▶ Step up and down large steps on the bus
- ▶ Get in and out of the bus seat unaided
- ▶ Secure their seatbelt
- ▶ Secure parcels/items at their seat, keeping aisles clear
- ▶ Recognize surroundings and navigate accordingly
- ▶ Proceed from the curb to the destination, and travel short distances from where the bus stops
- ▶ Communicate with the driver/dispatcher
